How to Become a Licensed Manufactured Housing Installer

Below are the details on how to access the online training through the Learning Center (Commonwealth of Virginia Learning Center)

- 1. From the main page, select "Need an account?". Then, you will select the "domain" that you want to access. From the drop-down box, select "DHCD Virginia Building Code Academy"
- 2. This approval request will come to DHCD and we'll approve within 1-2 business days. You'llget another email notification once your access is approved.
- 3. Once you are logged in, enter "manufactured home" into the search box. You should see three results: modules 1, 2, and 3.
- 4. Once all three modules are complete, follow instructions to print the Attendance certificates (there are 3 total certificates to print one for each of the three modules)
- 5. Mail attendance certificate and \$50 fee (check made payable to the Treasurer of Virginia) to:

Once we receive this, expect to receive your completion certificate within 7-10 business days. Once you have the certificate, you can then start the process with DPOR to have the MHC designation added to your contractor's license.
