Dear Sir or Madam:

The Town of Culpeper supports the positions of VML and the City of Lynchburg, as attached. Also, we have received the following comments from our Staff.

In regards to the Line of Duty Act funding (IND.VRS002) - This was originally passed by the state and funded by the state, but in their effort to reduce state funding obligations, the funding obligation was shifted to localities. Additionally, any pre-existing cases that were active within the LODA system had the funding burden shifted to the locality should the locality choose to use a non-VRS carrier. We ask that state funding be restored and this burden be taken off of localities.

In regards to SNR.DEQ031 (Compliance with Air Emissions Standards) – We are required to report for the WPCF since the boilers burn diesel fuel. The burden associated with this reporting seems unwarranted. We would recommend that WPCF's should be given a general exemption as long as they do not incinerate.

In regards to SNR.DEQ037 (Local & Regional Water Supply Plan) – Although we support the concept of requiring water supply planning, the required items to be included in the plan make plan development much more burdensome and costly than what would be required in a practical plan that would result in the same findings with much less cost and effort. The requirements should be reviewed from a more practical standpoint. Although we finished the RWSP last year, we will have to update it every 5 years...which will not be as time consuming but will be a huge waste of time.
