

Summary of 2009 Virginia Statewide Point-In-Time Count

Note: The 2009 Virginia Statewide Point-In-Time Count was conducted by continua of care throughout Virginia during January 2009. Each CoC conducted a sheltered count and unsheltered count of homeless persons in their jurisdiction. Sheltered persons are all adults, children, and unaccompanied youth residing in emergency and transitional housing, including domestic violence shelters, residential programs for runaway/homeless youth, and anyone using a hotel/motel/apartment voucher paid by a public/private agency because the person is homeless.







Note: Persons experiencing homelessness may, and often do, fall under more than one categorical subpopulation.


