**TO:** Users of Building and Fire Regulations

**FROM:** Paula Eubank, Associate Director, Technical Assistance Services Office (TASO), Division of Building and Fire Regulation

**SUBJ:** Errors in the Printing of the 2006 Building and Fire Regulations

**DATE:** February 11, 2009

The following is a list of errors which have been discovered in the printing (both paper and electronic) of the 2006 building and fire regulations of the Department. Please note that the official regulations on file with the Virginia Code Commission are correct, so regardless of the errors in the printings, the correct provisions are still enforceable.

#### **Uniform Statewide Building Code – Part I, Virginia Construction Code**

Section 310.5 – the reference to Section R324 of the IRC should be a reference to Section R325. (In both DHCD and ICC's printings.)

Appendix H (Signs) – Section H101.1 should have been deleted and Section H101.2 should not have been deleted. (ICC's printing only.)

#### **Uniform Statewide Building Code – Part II, Virginia Rehabilitation Code**

The chapter number for Performance Compliance Methods should be Chapter 13 instead of Chapter 12. (DHCD's printing only; ICC's printing is correct.)

#### **Virginia Statewide Fire Prevention Code**

Section 405.1 – the exception should read "Emergency evacuation drills shall not be conducted ... ." (In both DHCD and ICC's printings.)

Section 901.4.2 – the reference to Section 108.3.1 should be a reference to Section 103.8.1. (In both DHCD and ICC's printings.)

#### **Virginia Industrialized Building Safety Regulations**

Section 100A(1) – first sentence should read: "Verify through inspection ... has not been damaged in transit ... ." (DHCD's printing only; ICC's printing is correct.)
