



# Virginia Rent Relief **at a glance**



**\$938.9 million**

has been disbursed to households in Virginia

**180,743**

payments have been made in rent relief assistance

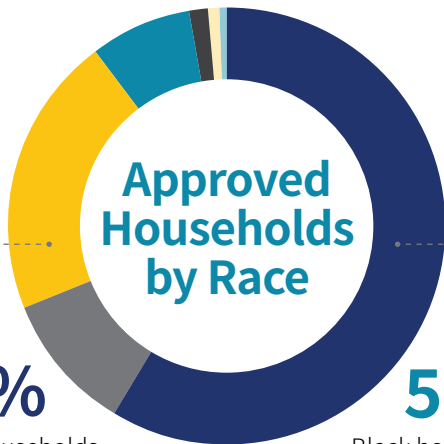
The household's total gross income must be equal to or less than 80% of area mean income to qualify. **More than 72%** of those approved had **area median incomes below 30%**.



Mortgage and rent relief has been disbursed\* through these state and federal resources:

- CARES: **\$62 million**
- Virginia Housing Trust Fund: **\$21 million**
- ERA 1.0: **\$520 million**
- ERA 2.0: **\$425.6 million**

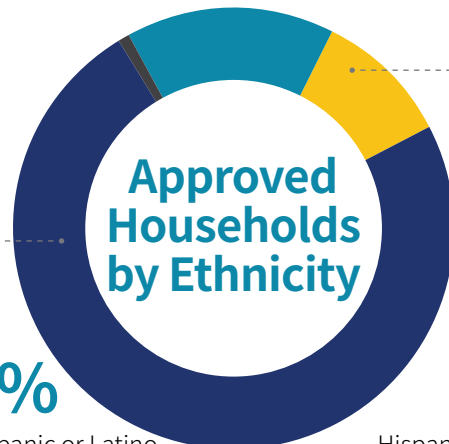
