

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

SELECTION OF SUBGRANTEE AND REALLOCATION OF FUNDS

Pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 440.15(d), the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments on the reallocation of funds and selection of one or more subgrantee(s) for thirteen counties and cities.

The public hearing is scheduled for Wednesday, January 19, 2022 at 2:30 p.m. and will be held virtually. The link for joining the hearing is:

The affected region encompasses the counties of Brunswick, Dinwiddie, Greensville, Lunenburg, Mecklenburg, Nottoway, Prince George, Surry and Sussex and the cities of Colonial Heights, Emporia, Hopewell and Petersburg. The subgrantee(s) will replace two subgrantees who no longer participate in the WAP.

Interested persons may provide comments regarding the reallocation of Weatherization Assistance Program funds in the region and designation of a new provider pursuant to federal regulations. The WAP is funded by the U.S. Department of Energy and is administered in the Commonwealth of Virginia by DHCD. The program's purposes are to increase the energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by low-income persons, reduce total residential energy expenditures and improve health and safety, especially for persons who are particularly vulnerable including the elderly, disabled, and children.
